Local fisherman Mitsos Koularas invites you on board of 'Agia Trias' for a fishing expedition on the Gulf of Kalloni. The Gulf is also called 'Aristotle's Lagoon', because it was here that Aristotle studied the propagation of animals like cuttlefish in the 4th century BC.

Mitsos will show you his daily job, depending on the time you wish to join him. At night, chasing the fish and laying the nets: early in the morning, collecting the nets and sorting the catch: or during the day, cleaning the nets, collecting seafood, relaxing and swimming. The expeditions start in the harbour of Skamnioudi.
